Santee Cooper

In 2003 and again in 2005, Overland Contracting Inc. (OCI) was selected by Santee Cooper to complete the following Maintenance and Outage Services (MOS) at the Winyah Generating Station located in Georgetown, South Carolina:

At Winyah Unit 2, OCI crews removed and installed 20 high-temperature superheat assemblies; 60 reheater assemblies, including 121 economizer/upleg stringer tubes; and performed additional miscellaneous boiler repairs.

On Winyah Unit 4, OCI was again responsible for the removal and replacement of 60 reheater assemblies, including 122 economizer/upleg stringer tubes, and performance of miscellaneous boiler repairs.

All outage work was completed on schedule and within budget.
